I understand and agree to these rules of use. By signing this agreement, I accept the below loan policy and agree that it is my responsibility to return this equipment to Esopus Library in good working condition and free from damage. I understand that I will pay the full replacement fee if the device is lost or damaged. The library is not responsible for any liability, damages or expense resulting from use or misuse of the device, connection of the device to other electronic devices, or data loss resulting from the use of the device.

Borrowing Patron must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Reside in the Town of Esopus
- Possess a current Esopus Library card for at least 3 months

Loan Parameters:

- Lending period is 2 weeks
- Limited to one hotspot per household
- Cannot be renewed or placed on hold
- Once a hotspot is returned, another may be checked out only if 2 hotspots are currently available.

Patron Responsibilities:

- The patron is financially responsible for damage, loss, theft, or tampering and, if this should occur, will pay the library for the value of the item, which is \$57. The full replacement fee will be incurred one day after the hotspot's original due date. (This fee will be removed upon return of the hotspot).
- If a hotspot is returned a week late or more, the patron's hotspot borrowing privileges will be suspended for 1 month.
- A missing or damaged cord will cost \$5, and a missing or damaged adapter will cost \$10.
- The lost and/or damaged fees noted are only an estimate. The Library reserves the right to adjust charges according to the damaged equipment make and model.
- If any technical problems are encountered, the device should be returned immediately to the library.

Return Procedures:

- Device must be returned directly to an Esopus library staff member.
- Do not return device in the book drop or to another library. Devices returned in the book drop will result in a \$25 fine.
- The device will be examined for evidence of damage or missing parts, and will be checked in once determined to be in its original working order.
- If the device is not returned and is billed to patron account, the library will turn off access to data.
